

Please limit your “favorites” to 100 photographs. Most coffee table books will include between 100-125 photographs. We will reference all of the photos from your wedding to supplement your favorites, and to provide consistency and a flow from page to page.

With so many photographs of your wedding, it is sometimes challenging to choose which should be featured in your coffee table book. We suggest thinking of your book as a storyboard of your wedding day, and encourage you to use the following checklist as a guideline for completing the narrative from beginning to end.
